#### From the Desk of Pastor Gary

When we get to this time of the year we always ask, "Where has the summer gone?" Schools are starting again. Football season is here. Vacations are over. And now we settle into our routines again. I always believed there are two New Years in each year: January 1st and the Sunday after Labor Day. This year that first Sunday after Labor Day is September 7<sup>th</sup> and it will be the day of New Beginnings here at Paxton Church.

- 1) A New Worship Series titled "Let My People Know." This seven-week series is about learning more about God so that we might strengthen our relationship with God.
- 2) We are restarting for some, and beginning for others, a Home Communion Ministry. We will be taking Communion to our friends of Paxton that cannot make it to worship on Sundays. We will have a short gathering after worship August 31st to help you serve this vital ministry. We will begin distributing Communion the week after September 7<sup>th</sup> Worship.
- 3) A New Sunday School Bible Study titled "The Bible with and without Jesus." We will learn how Christians and Jewish people read the same Bible stories differently. There is a weekly instructional video and a Participant Guide that I will order. The Guide provides readings that will allow you to be prepared to discuss the topic each week.
- 4) Our Wednesday Bible Study will start September 17<sup>th</sup> and we will be studying the Minor Prophets of the Old Testament this fall until Advent. We will be using the book "Be Amazed" by Warren W. Wiersbe. I used part of this book in our study of Jonah last fall.

I would like to express my appreciation to Jon, Skip and Liam for conducting the Sunday services while Cindy and I were on vacation.

Finally, we are always looking for new ideas for Fellowship Times at Paxton (i.e. game night, movie night...). If you have any ideas, please let a member of the Leadership Team know.
