"Repeat the Sounding Joy" is the theme guiding our Advent and Christmas season this year. The phrase comes from the beloved hymn **Joy to the World**, written more than 300 years ago by Pastor Isaac Watts, who loved to paraphrase Scripture into poetry. About forty years later, Lowell Mason set those words to the melody we know today.

We usually reserve Joy to the World for December, but it's truly a hymn for every season. It celebrates not only Christ's arrival in Bethlehem over 2,000 years ago, but also the promised day when He will come again. That is the heartbeat of Advent—learning how to wait faithfully.



This year, we will Prepare Him Room with Hope, Employ Our Songs with Love, rejoice as His Blessings Flow with Joy, and rest in the promise that He Rules the World with Peace.

Advent culminates when together we "Repeat the Sounding Joy" in our Christmas Eve celebration—but the story doesn't end there. Our rejoicing continues as we follow God's plan for us, watch for Christ's return, and live in His joy every day.

Join us throughout Advent and the Christmas season as we journey together in hope, love, joy, and peace while we wait for the One who is coming again.


Opportunities to Participate, Give and Serve

New Advent Bible study - Max Lucado.



Capital Campaign

The project replacing the roof & gutter between the Sanctuary and the education/children's wing has begun. Prior to the cold and snow showing up, a base coat was applied to 2 of the 3 sections. The third section and the application of top coat will be completed when the weather permits.

A third large TV has been purchased and will be installed at the back of the sanctuary before Christmas. This will improve readability for Pastor Gary, Skip, and other worship leaders.

At this point we have achieved 83% of our goal for 2025, with contributions totaling \$17,100. Thank you, Paxton, for your generosity.
