## From the Desk of Pastor Gary

The weather is warming, flowers are blooming, Lent has passed, and Easter decorations have been packed away until next year. Now, it's time to go fishing—Fishing for People.

This season between Easter and Pentecost offers the perfect opportunity to sharpen our skills in sharing the Good News. "Fishing for People" is not just a metaphor; it's a commissioning given directly by Jesus. In Matthew 28:19–20, He tells us:

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

The mission statement of The United Methodist Church echoes this call: we are to make disciples "for the transformation of the world." At Paxton, our vision statement continues this purpose: "Paxton United Methodist Church Exists to Grow and Share God's Love."

I invite you to join in this fishing expedition with your Prayers, Presence, Service, Talents, and Witness. Our mission to fish for people doesn't end on Pentecost Sunday—just as Pentecost in the Book of Acts marked the beginning of the Christian church, so it marks the start of our journey into our communities, casting our nets wide.

Later this month, on May 29th, 30th, and 31st, R.B. Wilbur (Paxton's Lay Representative to Annual Conference) and I will attend the Susquehanna Conference's Annual Conference in Williamsport. Lord and Savior – Jesus Christ.







We would like to express our appreciation to everyone who shared their time, talents, financial support, and presence at the various activities: pancake supper, pancake breakfast, Holy Week services, and, of course, Easter Sunday.

<u>Easter Eggs:</u> Over 13,000 eggs were prepared and sold throughout our community and beyond. Some 20 + people volunteered 5-8 hours weekly including friends, church members and a group from Annapolis that took 30 dozen eggs back with them to Maryland. The funds raised will support the work of the church.

**Hearing Assistance System**: A hearing assistance device is now available during worship in the sanctuary. See Bill or Cindy (in the booth at the back of the sanctuary) before any service if you would like to use it. This system is made available in memory of Tom Meredith through a donation by his wife, Judy Meredith.

**Peanut Butter Challenge:** For those facing food insecurity, peanut butter is a staple. Paxton participated in a district-wide United Methodist challenge to help our brothers and sisters. **Over 200 jars** of peanut butter were collected and will be donated to The Hanna Food Pantry in Susquehanna Twp. and The Manna Food Pantry in Penbrook. Thank you, Paxton, for your generosity!



<u>Audio-visual Changes:</u> Our current video system is old and fading. At times, it can be very hard to see the lyrics and words for the response readings. Help is on the way! The church has purchased two very large screen (100 inches) television sets. These should provide for more vivid video presentations and greater clarity of sound. Installation is expected by mid-May.

## Rise Against Hunger – 68% of our fundraising goal has been reached.

Come join us on **Saturday**, **May 17<sup>th</sup>**, to package emergency meals for **Rise Against Hunger**, an organization committed to ending hunger. Volunteers are needed to fill the bags & boxes with 10,000 meals that will be distributed throughout the world. Additional information and sign-up sheets are in the church lobby.
