<u>Gift Giving Opportunities</u>

As the Leadership committee continues to discuss and plan ways to respond to your comments on the Consecrated Life Sheets, we've created some new opportunities in the area of Gifts, which was one of the categories. The other categories were Prayer, Presence, Service and Witness. Under the category of Gifts many of you noted that you wanted to take a new step in giving financial resources to Paxton and to God, and specifically some of you noted you wanted the opportunity to finance special building improvement projects.

With that response noted, we developed a "wish list" or "special projects list" of sorts, which you can find on the back of this page. We will continue adding to this list as some items get completed. And, please, if you have additional ideas, share them with Scot Dundore, our Trustee Chair, or any member of the Leadership Committee.

The list includes an updated Assisted Listening System, which would provide high quality audio for those who need assistance hearing to fully participate in our worship service. A new Video/Projection System would improve everyone's ability to see the worship slides and videos more clearly, especially the congregants who need visual assistance, so they, too, can fully participate in our worship service. Some other items on our wish list are needed to update our well-used Sunday School classrooms, meeting rooms and fellowship hall. Special Projects List

- 1. Assisted Listening System The old system has one working hearing device and performs okay at best. A new system would cost about \$1,100. It would provide up to four listening devices and a huge improvement in audio quality. This would assist any of our members that need help hearing the worship service clearly. Installation would be done by our in-house work group.
- 2. Sanctuary Video Screens Replace existing projectors and screens with large TV Monitors. The quality of picture would be greatly enhanced and improve the overall appearance of the sanctuary. The current estimated cost for a 100" TV is \$2500 each plus brackets to mount the TV and the cabling needed to hook it up. Installation would be done by our in-house work group.
